I would like to thank all the exhibitors for giving me such a lovely entry. I would also thank the officers and committee for providing such a pleasant and professional show and my stewards who kept things moving efficiently throughout the day.

My overall impressions of the breed on this occasion were rather mixed. On the one hand I found many exhibits with most of the breed characteristics, even if I

was unable to place a number of them on the day because of the larger entry in some classes. On the other hand, I found quite a number with worrying faults such as badly undershot or crooked teeth, steep shoulders, short ribcages and bad rear or unbalanced movement. As I have often said, it is certainly different judging them to watching them from the ringside. The following is somewhat repetitive but reflects the main points I was looking for.

MPD (16, 5)

1. Llewellyn's Degarbo Dark And Debonair, b, 8 month old youngster with nice head and expression, pleasing outline, good conformation and nicely balanced movement with level topline, moved and showed well.
2. Waterhouse's Chtaura Dream Lover, b/w, good head and expression, well laid shoulders, well ribbed, covered the ring well, promising youngster.
3. Poole's Domensa All That Jazz.

PD (10, 2)

1. Phillips' Dimara Gorgeous George, g/brin, 11 month old youngster quite mature for his age, lovely head and expression, good conformation with nice layback of shoulders, good bone and muscle, good balanced movement with level topline which was held on the move, looked nice from all angles. **BPIS**.
2. Gillman's Mytilene The Mighty Quinn, b/w, nice type with good head and expression, well ribbed back, good angulation, moved and showed well.
3. Holland's Vaderlands Feel The Force.

JD (9, 5)

1. Skerm's Chethang Lisandro, g, good head and expression, good bone and muscle, well put together with nice level topline, good controlled movement, showed well.
2. Williams' Simuje Valentino, silver/b, Good head and expression, good conformation with good layback of shoulders, nice balanced movement, showed well.
3. Rogers' Shigatse Orlando At Phalassoa.

YD (9, 3)

1. Brown's Chethang Kesario, cream, good head and expression, good bone and muscle, good conformation, excellent movement with level topline, covered the ring with ease.
2. Skerm's Chethang Lisandro (very close to 1).
3. Llewellyn's Degarbo Sunset.

ND (6, 4)

1. Skerm's Chethang Lisandro.
2. Hart's Zentarr Warwick Of Khazedel, g, 10 month old youngster with nice head and expression, nice angulation and topline, moved and showed well.

GD (5, 2)

1. Gillman's Mytilene The Mighty Quinn.
2. Rogers' Shigatse Orlando At Phalassoa, g, nice head and expression, good bone and muscle, nice conformation with level topline, showed well.
3. Watterson's Rictovia Somebody To Love.

PGD (12, 3)

1. Paradise' Shardlow Pilot Of The Future JW ShCM, silver, good head and expression, excellent well balanced movement, level topline which was held on the move, moved and showed well.
2. Lock's Littondale Palladio, g, good head and expression good conformation, shoulders well laid, very close to 1.
3. Gillman's Naughty But Nice JW ShCM.

LD (21, 8)

1. Scott's Wolferlow Merlot, red/g, excellent head and expression, good neck on well laid shoulders, good conformation, excellent balanced movement, covered the ring well.

2. Saunders' Bellellen Boy O'Boy, grey, so very close to 1 that all the same comments apply.

3. Gillman's Midnight Cowboy JW ShCM.

OD (9, 2)

1. Luscott's Ch Jalus Galileo JW, cream, excellent type, good head and expression with that lovely soft expression so typical of the breed, good neck on well laid shoulders, excellent conformation producing good balanced movement with plenty of reach and drive, level topline, covered the ring with ease, in excellent coat. **DCC, RBIS & BOS.**

2. Davis' Marchtru San Marquis At Narmoak, b/w, different type to 1 but with excellent head and expression, good bone and muscle, good conformation giving a pleasing outline, good balanced movement with level topline, moved and showed well. **RDCC.**

3. Bell's Ch Nedlik De Bato Of Vallena.

VD (2, 1)

1. Ch & Am Ch Chtaura Dream Machine, g, 8 year old in excellent condition, good head and expression, good layback of shoulders, good bone and muscle, moved and showed well, nicely balanced on the move..

MPB (11, 2)

1. Leaver's Shogandale Aqua Top Lady, g/w, very eye catching 7 month old with nice head and expression, well ribbed, good layback of shoulders, good loin, well angulated, moved and showed well. **RBPIS.**

2. Holmes' Showa Madame George At Chergram, g, another 7 month old with good head and expression, nicely put together with nice conformation and good bone and muscle, nice balanced movement with level topline, moved and showed well, close to 1.

3. Plumstead's Showa Making Music.

1. Hattrell's Jalus High Class At Khinjan, light g, nice pleasing shape with good conformation, good rib and loin, nice head and expression, covered the ring well.
2. Warner's Snowtalia Kitsi Girl, nice head and expression, nice neck on well laid shoulders, good angulation, moved and showed well.
3. Church's Snowtalia Divine By Design At Askja.

JB (12, 3)

1. Torrance's Sinyul Luv Me Do, grey/w, good head and expression, excellent neck on very well laid shoulders, good conformation giving excellent balanced movement with good level topline, covered the ring with such ease, I will watch this one with great interest as she matures.
2. Blaber's Chethang Laurencia At Jastina, cream, very close to 1 with good head and expression, good conformation, nice balanced movement, moved and showed well.
3. Bushell's Jamikasoka Shady Lady.

YB (11, 1)

1. Harvey's Faerdorn About To Dazzle, red/g, lovely head and expression, good neck and layback of shoulders, lovely balanced movement, showed well.
2. Richardson's Belazieth Hello Paper Doll, b/w, lovely head and expression, good neck on well laid shoulders, good balanced movement with nice level topline, moved and showed well.
3. Waterhouse's Chtaura Sealed With A Kiss.

NB (4, 1)

1. Warner's Snowtalia Kitsi Girl.
2. Church's Snowtalia Divine By Design At Askja, g, good head and expression, good bone and muscle, good neck on well laid shoulders, nice conformation, moved and showed well.
3. Pinkerton's Simuje Karenzia.

GB (7, 1)

1. Torrance's Sinyul Luv Me Do.
2. Church's Askja Popcorn'N'Peanuts, brindle, lots to like, lovely head and expression, good conformation, nicely balanced movement with nice level topline, showed well.
3. Bedford's Sangchenla Pandora.

PGB (16, 4)

1. Seward's Elleonia On The Dark Side, grey/w, lovely type with excellent head and expression, well put together with nice balanced movement, good angulation, moved and showed well.
2. Plumstead's Simark Lucy Lockett Of Showa, b, Good head and expression, shoulders well laid, well ribbed, nice balanced movement with level topline, covered the ring well.
3. Waterhouse's Chtaura She Will Be Loved.

LB (13, 1)

1. Leaver's Iced Gems At Shogandale, b/w, 6 year old with excellent head and expression, good conformation with good rib and loin, excellent balanced movement, covered the ring with ease, looked good from all angles.
2. Ellis' Nedlik An-Paris, b/w, very close to 1 with again good head and expression, good neck on well laid shoulders, well ribbed, good angulation, good bone and muscle, good movement with level topline.
3. Askja Stars in your Eyes at Littondale

OB (17, 2)

1. Waterhouse's Ch Chtaura All U Need Is Luv JW, grey, 4 year old who, on the day would not be denied the top honours, beautifully put down, excellent head and expression with lovely dark eyes giving that intense but soft expression, good neck on well laid shoulders, excellent conformation, level topline, balanced movement

with good reach and drive, in excellent coat and commanded the ring throughout. **BCC & BOB**.

2. Scholes' Ch Rossgilde Tamegans Dream JW ShCM, light gold, another classic bitch with lovely head and expression, well bodied, good layback of shoulders, good conformation and good balanced movement with level topline, in good coat, looked good from all angles. **RBCC**.

3. Luscott's Jalus Goldilocks.

VB (5, 1)

1. Church's Askja Fantasia, g, 10 year old in fine fettle, good head and expression, good bone and muscle, well ribbed back, good conformation, moved and showed well. **BVIS**.

2. Holland's Ch Vaderlands Flame and Fortune, g, 9 year old, lighter type than 1, nice head and expression, good angulation, well bodied, nice balanced movement, moved and showed well.

3. Free's Saxonsprings Sunrise at Marpori ShCM.

BRACE (5, 3)

1. Scarll's, moved well together most of the time and complemented one another in colour, size and type, both moved with drive and purpose.

2. Bulloch's, they matched in colour but not quite in size, moved fairly well together but on occasions got a little tangled up, however they made a good effort.
